

## **Hipster made with straight needles**

### **Materials:**

- 1 skein (or some left over) worsted weight wool yarn
- 1 pair size 10 straight needles
- Size I (5.5 mm) crochet hook



### **Directions:**

1. Leaving a 12 inch tail, cast on 10 stitches
2. Working in garter stitch (knit every row), increase 1 stitch at the beginning of every row 20 times (30 stitches on the needle)
3. Continue in garter stitch without further shaping until body measures 24 inches
4. Bind off. Stop here and go to Step 8, if you wish or continue with step 5
5. Bring bound off edge to about 1/2" below beginning of shaping. Sew side seams.
6. With crochet hook and yarn tail, chain 10 or so stitches and attach at other end to form the button loop
7. Weave in ends
8. With crochet hook leave an 8 inch tail and using a chain stitch, make a 60 inch strap finishing with another 8 inch tail before cutting yarn.
9. Send all to me for felting
